### POINTS SECRETARY

I hope everyone has had a chance to check out the new WHO Points page, there is a link on the WHO website. This provides you a great place to check your horse/rider numbers, view results, current averages, points and classifications. If you are uncertain about your classification or think that you may have rated up in a class you might want to take the time to double check them prior to entering a show. Remember if you run out of your classified class you are running for TIME ONLY. Your time will not count for averages nor will your points count. Also, I know we have been saying to for years, but I want to remind you that it is YOUR responsibility to check your entries on the pink sheets at the show to make sure that your horse/rider numbers and times are written down correctly. Results are posted as they are written on those class sheets and we go by numbers, so if it is incorrect or not written at all it won't be recorded. The ONLY exception to this is new riders who have not yet been issued numbers. I hope you understand that it is much easier for you to double check your own information on the pink sheets than it is for the point secretaries to look up numbers/name for everyone at the show.

Since I am only human, please make sure to let me know if you come across a mistake on your information or results.

## RULE PROPOSALS

### **2017 Rule change proposals:**

Submitted by Leslie Davis and Geri Deskins

1. Current rule says: To maintain a Judges/Timers card, he/she must keep up membership, attend at least one clinic, judge or time one show, do a take home test and send it to the Judges and Timers Chairman.

Proposed rule: To maintain a Judges/Timers card he/she must keep up a membership in good standing, attend at least one clinic, judge or time one show. If the person has been a Judge/Timer for five (5) or more years, no annual test is required. If a person has been a Judge/Timer for less than five (5) years than the annual test is required.

When the Judges/Timers test is revised ALL current Judges/Timers will be required to take it. (Once for > five year, annually for < five years.)

Board is in favor of this change.

2. Housekeeping? Change the wording on “Grandfathered-in” Judges and timers to be titled “Option 2” of obtaining a Judges/Timer card.

3. Current rule reads: PeeWee awards will be given to the pee wees that have ridden at three shows throughout the year.

Proposed rule: PeeWee awards will be given to the pee wees that have ridden at six shows throughout the year.

If passed this will also affect the wording under the Beat Washington Show, which would also have to be changed to reflect the six show minimum.
