MINUTES 7/29/2017
WHO Summer Show – Twisted Bit

Meeting called to order by President Tully Ferrando at 6:05 pm on July 29, 2017

Roll was taken. Those present were: Tully, Leslie, Sherri, Jessica, Pam, Tosha, Suzie, Eileen, Geri, Terri, Stacey, Marilyn, Jerry, Von and Princess Erica.

Minutes from previous meeting were presented. Stacey made a motion to accept as written, Sherri seconded and minutes were approved as written.

Treasurer's report Stacey made a motion to accept the report as written, Marilyn seconded and the report was approved by the board.

Correspondence: A Thank You card was received from the Barber Family. It read,

Committee Reports:

Newsletter: Von reports that all is good.

Website:

Classification: Eileen had nothing to report. There was also a discussion about what to do with riders who ride out of class. See page 39...

Points Secretaries: HOUSEKEEPING RULE. See page 43. There was a discussion about white or yellow sheets not getting to the points secretaries in a timely fashion...sometimes as much as 1½ weeks late. It is very important that the sheets arrive as soon as possible so times can be entered, classification cards sent out and everything be as up to date as possible. It was decided that from now on, the sheets will be mailed by Priority mail in a flat rate envelope, which is about \$6.56. The envelope can also be tracked. It was decided that the sheets would be sent Priority Mail within 48 hours of the show (in other words no later than Tuesday if it is a 2 day show). If the postmark is after Tuesday, there will be a \$25 per day penalty. The exception to the above relates to the last show of the season. If you are not able to physically hand the sheets to the points secretaries, they are to be mailed by Priority Mail within 24 hours of the show. Reason for exception, Interstate notifications have to be out to the riders by the 10th of August and riders must respond by the 15th of August. Interstate notifications will be sent by text message, email or regular mail. Suzie made a motion that the above be accepted and the rule books be updated. Eileen seconded the motion and it was passed by the board.

Judges/Timers: Jerry Ross recommended that Austin Kennell be approved as a tentative timer and John Fowler as a tentative judge. The board approved.

Rules/Committee:

Beat Washington Meet: Show will be held at Horse Haven. A neighbor said they were having a wedding at their house and asked that there be quiet Saturday from 5:00 to 5:30 pm.

Convention: Will be held at Salem Convention Center. General meeting starts at 10:00 a.m. Judges and Timers meeting to follow.

Annual Awards: Tosha reported all was good.

Interstate: Kathy Moody will have tickets for the Queen's Breakfast and all Oregon riders will need to check in with her for stall assignment, payment and to sign the release. Marilyn Norris will take entries for the Friday night Open Show. Tosha proposed that everyone dress in purple in memory of Evelyn Barber and to show support for the Alzheimer Association at the Open Show. Riders wanting to be flag carriers need to see Tully. There are a couple of concerts this year, one on Thursday night ... Nickelback, and on Sunday...Lady Antebellum. Alternative routes will be in effect starting at 2:30 pm on those days. Interstate 2018 will be held at Clark County Fairgrounds.

JR Director: Jr. show went very well. Jr. account has a balance of \$4,862.23 now.

Historian: Kenra not present.

Hall of Fame/Gold Card: Kathy Moody not present.

Old Business: Re Bonding/one signature ... Leslie said she was waiting for ____ from Betsy.

New Business: Ryan's program is going good. Suzie volunteered to keep track and input entries for a year and Chris would be the auditor of Suzie's work.

Suzie wants the white sheets and only wants one person to issue rider and horse numbers. Motion was made by Suzie and seconded by Eileen and Tosha. The board approved that Suzie would issue numbers and would get all the white sheets, starting with August 1st. Chris was not in attendance for the meeting, but was told of the decision.
