New Rule Proposal- Submitted by Stacy Hardin

Rule Change Proposal I- Submitted by Stacy Hardin

Current Rule:

Each contestant will be charged a Judges and Timers fee of \$2.00 per rider per day (Page 43).

Proposed Rule:

Each contestant will be charged a Judges and Timers fee of \$5.00 per rider per day.

Comments and Reasons:

Judges and Timers do the majority of the arena work, set up and take down. May also encourage more members to become a judge and/or timer.

Rule Change Proposal II- Submitted by Stacy Hardin

Current Rule:

Under Pole bases: Black rubber base, 14 lbs, 6 inches tall, 14 inches across. Total weight, with pole and converter approximately 16 lbs.

Proposed Rule:

Black rubber or plastic base, 6 inches tall, 14 inches across. Total weight, with pole and converter approximately 16 lbs.

Comments and Reasons:

Rubber bases are difficult to find. Plastic ones are more common. As long as total weight is the same as rubber, it should not matter.

Rule Change Proposal III- Submitted by Stacy Hardin

Current Rule:

A complete list of contestants and horses, together with their official times and placings must be mailed to the point secretary within 24 hours following the show. (page 43)

Proposed Rule:

A complete list of contestants and horses together with their official times and placings must be mailed to the point secretaries within 72 hours following the show.

Comments and Reasons:

Not possible to mail out if only having a show on Saturday. Some Mondays post office is closed. For some, post office not open when they have to be at work and they are closed when they get off.
