NEW RULES

We have **Two New Rules** that were passed at the July 28th General Meeting.

1. Recipients have the option of choosing cash or plaques. Points for stacked awards will be worth \$1.00 each. Recipient must declare at the beginning of the point year which award they want - cash or plaque.

This changes the rule of recipients not having the option for cash if they have less than 20 points.

2. Non-Members will not receive points.

This changes that when non-members place their points go to no one. Now points will go to the next placing member.

- **PLEASE** follow the ground rules below. **No Loose Dogs** is a continuing problem and alcohol is only allowed in your RV.
- Western wear is required at the Open Show. Donations this year go to Oregon Food Bank.
- WHO Juniors clean up after the potluck on Friday.

CLARK COUNTY EVENTS CENTER GROUND RULES:

1. All infractions will be determined by Interstate Committee members from Oregon and Washington.
 2. Riders and spectators may be excused, and/or barred from grounds or further competition if rules are broken.
 3. ALL dogs must be on leash – or – tied in camp at all times. You are to “Scoop the Poop” and put it in the proper receptacle.
- NO LOOSE DOGS**
4. Horse trailers not used as living quarters are to be parked in the designated area outside the arena area. No exceptions. Living quarter trailers must stay in the parking lot or the camping area. NO horses allowed in the camping area on the south side of the arena.
 5. No one under 21 may possess or consume alcohol. No containers allowed outside your camp. This includes arena, stands, dances, breakfast or other functions.
 6. No bicycles, rollerblades, skateboards, scooters, etc. allowed in arena. No bicycles, rollerblades, skateboards, scooters, etc. are allowed in the barn area during competition.
 7. All fees must be paid before competition starts.
 8. All riders – Oregon and Washington – will ride under Interstate Rules.
 9. All riders – judges -- timers and stewards – must wear western shirt and pants, while riding or working show in arena.
 10. No inhumane treatment or excessive abuse to animals will be tolerated.
 11. Please clean up your camping area and put garbage in the proper receptacle.

Clark County Event Center Alcohol Policy for distribution and consumption at the Clark County Event Center:

Alcohol service and consumption at the Clark County Event Center is allowed only within approved designated areas and in accordance with the Sports and Entertainment License and Operating Plan approved by the Washington State Liquor Control Board. Possession, service or consumption of alcoholic beverages anywhere else on the grounds, including parking areas, is strictly prohibited. This prohibition does not include inside private RV's located on the grounds for a specific event. It does include all other vehicles.

Visibly intoxicated person or persons exhibiting impaired behavior will not be allowed to remain on the grounds. They will either be placed into the charge of sober friends or relatives to be taken home or transportation will be arranged for them at their expense.

Persons not adhering to this policy or refusing to leave the grounds when ordered to do so by authorized personnel are subject to trespass procedures, citation, and/or possible arrest.

This means no alcohol is allowed outside of your RV. Walking around with alcoholic beverages is not permitted.

Open fire pits are not allowed on grounds. A BBQ is ok.

No cooking or heating in barns is allowed (this includes crock pots and coffee makers).

No propane/fuel containers under any roof.

No modifications to the stalls can be made by participants.

MINUTES 5/23/2018
Horse Haven arena

Meeting called to order by President Tully Ferrando at 5:50 pm

Roll was taken. Members present were: Tully, Betsy, Alyssa, Austin, Sherry, Leslie, Pam, Levi, Stacey, Suzie, Nick, Matt, Marilyn and Tosha.

Minutes from previous meeting were presented. Nick made a motion to accept as written, Betsy seconded and minutes were approved as written.

Treasurer's report: Leslie presented the report, no questions or concerns. Betsy made a motion to approve the report as written, Tosha seconded and the report was approved as written.

Committee reports:

Newsletter: Von not present

Website: Ryan not present

Classification: Eileen not present

Point Secretaries: Sherry mentioned that at a couple shows (mostly Roseburg) that it is very important for the time writer's to compare placings/results as some of the sheets aren't matching. Suzie will send a reminder to Von to put in the newsletter.

Judges and Timers: Nick is working on test discrepancies and going through the information he was given from Jerry. He also presented a list of concerns by other members on rule bending and preferential treatment. Nick also asked what to do with the returned tests. Matt made a motion to move Nick to a permanent timer, it was seconded and the Board approved.

Rules Committee: Discussion was held about "how points are figured". There is not a clear description in the rulebook (both current and past) about the process. The issue becomes that if a nonmember or a person riding out of their classification places in that class than do those points get taken from a paid member riding in their classified class? The nonmember/time only run does NOT receive points but does that mean the paid member should get those points or take the next point value and the higher point value is just not assigned? Susie needed a clarification to enable Ryan to program the computer program correctly. Susie will send Von a clarification on how the points process is done and Von will send out an e-mail vote to the membership on how the membership wants the points awarded. ALL times qualify for Interstate and classification but points are only given to paid members in their classified class.

It was also mentioned that the topic of the year end award plaques was mentioned at the last meeting but not included in the minutes. Currently the rule book states that anyone receiving less than 20 points will get a plaque/trophy, even if they elect cash. Tosha wants to have all cash requests be paid cash regardless of the amount. As this is a rule change, it needs to be a written rule change proposal sent to the membership to vote on.

Beat Washington Meet: Horse Haven, will be fast time event halters.

Show Approvals: Terri not present but website should be up to date. SOGO will have a show on July 4th and a show at Estes in August.

Convention: Salem again. Bonny and Wendy helping Alyssa.

Annual Awards: Working on them
