## **RULE PROPOSALS**

There are two rule proposals to be voted on at the November 24th General Meeting –

### **1. Rule Change *submitted by Stacey Hardin***

Current Rule – Under Section 1: At all Western Horsemen of Oregon shows the decision of the judge is final. Each show shall retain two judges and two timers. They will each receive a portion of the two dollar(\$2) per rider fee.

Proposed Rule – Under Section 1: At all Western Horseman of Oregon shows the decision of the judge is final. Each show shall retain two judges and two timers. They will each receive a portion of the five dollar (\$5) per rider fee.

Comments and Reason for Rule Change – The compensation for membership has been removed. Judges & Timers spend most of their time running back and forth from riding to judging and should be compensated appropriately.

### **2. Rule Change *submitted by Stacey Hardin***

Current Rule – Under section 7: Rider may not enter an event after it has started (A, B, C, & D being one event). Rider may not add a class after event has started.

Proposed Rule – Rider may not enter an event or class after it has started with the exception of adding oneself to the Open class. It will be the riders responsibility to ensure rider and horse numbers have been recorded.

Comments and Reason for Rule Change – Many show producers allow this already. We need consistency and doing so would only help WHO with funds.
