## Rule Proposals:

There are three proposals to be voted on at the General meeting.

1. New rule—*submitted by Marilyn Norris* 

When there is a shortage of a judge and/or timer, in an individual event only, a person that is both a qualified judge and timer is allowed to be the judge and timer for said event until a judge or timer is available to take over the duty of a judge or timer. The one person judge and timer cannot be the same in any team event or keyhole. This is only to be used in a "temporary" situation and not for the purposes of an entire show.

Reason—

Judges and timers working in the arena, setting courses, running equipment, etc. need to have time to prepare for their run and take care of there horses before and after. Also help the show run more smoothly. Board in Favor

2. Addition of the rule—submitted by Tom Delker Rule states that you should put 12 lbs of water in each barrel. Add that clubs could put a steel ring on the bottom inside lip of the barrel so the weight is consistent in the barrels. (Will have example and explanation at meeting)
